we submit that we fully support the ACCCs Notice against eBay Australias forcement of Paypal over users.

There has been no evidence presented by ebay to support claims that PayPal is a 'safer' payment method against leading and wider used Bank Deposits, Internet Deposits and other forms of payment methods currently (as at June 14th 2008) in use across eBay Australia and which have successfully been used by both Sellers and Buyers for many years in conjunction with eBay Australia auctions.

We reaffirm our first submission's statements lodged on the 18/4/2008 sighting detriment under eBays proposed forcement of paypal over all users, eBays responses to the needs of their userbase has been far from diplomatic and much closer to insulting, where notices and releases from eBay have said we as users are either 'wrong', 'delusional' or other, where infact our own accounting shows the clear detriment the proposed forcement of PayPal is causing even now to sales and figures.
