I have read the eBay notification and their submissions to the ACCC about exclusive dealing. I have also read many submissions against the proposed conduct and the ACCC's draft notice of revocation.

I agree with the ACCC's draft notice as I believe eBay's proposed conduct would decrease competition and not have an overall public benefit.

I was one of the almost 700 people/organisations that lodged a submission against ebay's proposal.

I have been selling on ebay since 2000 and have only ever accepted direct deposit or money order as a payment option - I will only continue to sell on ebay so long as I do not have to offer Paypal as a payment option.

If I choose to sell on ebay and only accept direct deposit and a buyer wishes to accept my payment terms, then it is no one elses business apart from the buyer and seller. Ebay are only providng the venue for the sale to take place and are in no way, shape or form involved in my sale/transaction.

Please do NOT allow ebay to remove our rights as to how we get paid! I hope you take into consideration the matter and eventually revoke immunity for ebay's PayPal only policy and as stated allow direct deposit or money only as a payment option if a seller chooses these options.
