I would like to add my comments as a eBay buyer and Powerseller since 2004 with over 3100 feedback scores and a feedback rating of 99.4%.

So many people I have spoken to are very worried about using the internet for payments. They **do not** feel that the internet is a safe place for financial transactions. They are still very happy to purchase from the eBay site just not happy to use the internet for financial transactions.

That is the one major reason this is so unfair. These people now have no way of paying for the items they would like to purchase off the eBay site.

In the past these people used money orders, cheques or go to a bank to make a payment directly into the sellers account. Money Orders can be stopped if they get lost in transit and must be signed with ID given so seller can receive cash and with bank payments a receipt is given as notification of payment. This is documentation that can be checked on if any problems occur just like eBay's PayPal.

I believe there is no reason for eBay to be allowed to use PayPal exclusively.
