I would like to take this opportunity to submit my objection to allowing EBay to exclude all lines of payment other than PayPal on their Australian auction site as per their notification to the ACCC.

I do not believe that PayPal (being owned by EBay) would be any more a secure form of payment than those already offered and surely that choice should be made between the Buyer and the Seller. By having to give PayPal and EBay credit or bank details the number of people with access to this sensitive and private information would greatly increase. Not to mention the massive financial gain to PayPal. I believe the current system gives the Australian public the freedom to choose.
