Hello Lauren,

Thanks for sending this information to me so promptly. It is much appreciated.

I am very pleased with the contents of the draft notice. It is wonderful that the ACCC has been able to accept the thrust of the bulk of the submissions.

I understand that I am able to make a further submission at this stage.

Everything I included in my original submission of 2/5/08 still applies.

I would like, however, to emphasise my request that ACCC in their final notice continues to ensure that both stage 1 (PayPal required) and stage 2 (PayPal exclusively) of eBay's proposed conduct be denied. It is important in this respect to understand how eBay presents an invoice to the buyer on behalf of the seller. Where PayPal is offered, it is always offered as the default, and because of this, it occupies a large proportion of the space on the invoice. The seller has no control over this. To this extent, eBay manipulates the buyer into choosing the "easy" (PayPal) option, making this situation almost exactly the same as the PayPal only solution.

Allowing stage 1 as a "compromise" solution would not really be acceptable.

If you feel it is appropriate to treat this as a further submission, I would appreciate that. Again, I would appreciate the removal of any address/contact information from this if placed on the public record.
