I wish to submit my objection to the compulsory offering of Paypal only in regards to Ebay.com.au.

I have concerns regarding the ability of Ebay to provide sufficient security for their Paypal arm. It appears to be ad hoc to say the least. As I have these concerns, both as a buyer and a seller on ebay, I do not wish to use Paypal, and therefore must object to having my right to choice of payment taken from me.

I also wish to lodge an objection to the current invoicing style that ebay are using. Paypal only is offered on the first page of invoice, even though other methods of payment have been offered in the listing of item for purchase. It is only by clicking 'continue' button to next page, that a tiny button appears at bottom of page to allow access of Direct Deposit details. I believe this to not be in the spirit of the direction by the ACCC to ebay, that they must allow other payment methods to be offered.
