As an Ebay Power Seller who generates all his income from Ebay I wish to thank you for the draft notice to revoke in relation to notification N93365. I very much hope you are able to continue and provide a final notice.

I thoroughly disagree with Ebay's contention that your action reduces protection for consumers purchasing online. Their stance continues to be both cynical and disingenuous.

The major benefit they tout of \$20,000 protection has NO EFFECT on any item I have ever sold, bought or am likely to do so - they could as well make it \$20 million or \$20 trillion and it would be equally meaningless. It applies to so few transactions as to make it merely a gimmick.

The other area with which I am uncomfortable regards the undisclosed statistics upon which Ebay and PayPal base their arguments re. security of various payments methods and relative frequency of BBEs. Without this information it is very hard to agree with any of their rhetoric, which is in complete contrast to personal experience of such matters (now for over 3300 transactions in my case).
