Dear Lauren,

It might be too late for us to lodge this submission for the subject notification. As it affects our business seriously as we sell products on eBay only, we have to try our best to express ourselves.

eBay force sellers to use PayPal as the only payment option (pay on collection is almost not a valid option for most sellers as many operates privately and don't allow pick up).

There are many problems with PayPal system:

1. There is no doubt that many online shoppers still reluctant to expose their credit card or bank detail through internet. The proposed exclusive dealing notification will remove the rights of ebay shoppers to pay in a secure way they believe
2. It is unfair to remove the rights of eBay selling businesses to select a cheaper option to receive payment from buyers.
3. fund clearance is extremely slow if buyers pay through PayPal by taking fund from their bank account. Normally take 5-7 working days. Buyers don't need to wait that long if they can use BPAY or direct bank deposit, internet transfer etc options
4. we have spent money to set up BPAY, EFPOS etc. electronic payment facilities for our eBay selling business. The proposed Paypal only payment will waste all our financial setup.
5. This proposal might drive many out of business.
