Dear Mr Samuels, Ms Roy, to whom it may concern,

I have read the eBay notification and their submissions to the ACCC regarding exclusive dealing. I have also read many submissions against the proposed conduct and the ACCC's draft notice of revocation.

1. I am in total support of the ACCC draft decision regarding exclusive Paypal forcing.
2. I agree that stage 1 should be rolled back immediately.
3. I agree that Paypal should be compelled to sign the EFT code of conduct.
4. I would like to request that the ACCC examine the policy under which sellers registered after Jan 2007 must offer paypal.
It follows that if paypal can not be forced across the board it should also not be forced for newer sellers.
An interesting observation on this point is that the policy has already been modified to state *'eBay requires sellers to offer payments through PayPal (with some exceptions set out in the Policy below).'*
