Third line forcing notification N94251 lodged by BP Australia Pty Ltd

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 7 October 2009. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

BP and American Express propose to provide a new, co-branded AMEX/BP corporate card and an existing AMEX/Qantas corporate card entitling cardholders to bi-annual rebates based on purchases at BP service establishments and enhanced data capturing and reporting on fuel and other spends at BP establishments.

Legal immunity conferred by the notification commenced on 21 October 2009.

On the basis of the information that you have provided, it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the immunity afforded by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

This assessment has been made on the basis that BP and American Express will disclose all relevant terms and conditions to prospective customers.
