Third line forcing notifications N94325 & N94327-8 lodged by MasterCard Asia/Pacific (Australia) Pty Ltd

I refer to the above third line forcing notifications lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 17 and 18 November 2009. The notifications have been placed on the ACCC's public register.

Under notification N94325 MasterCard proposes to offer 'applause' vouchers (to be used on the MasterCard 'applause' website) to consumers on condition that they acquire a MasterCard debit card from the Bank of Western Australia.

Under notifications N94327-8 MasterCard proposes to offer consumers the following prizes as part of two trade promotions:

- flights, concert tickets, accommodation and spending money ('Bands' promotion)
- concert tickets (Future Music Festival promotion)

on condition that they acquire a MasterCard debit card from a third party financial institution in Australia that offers MasterCard debit cards.

Legal immunity conferred by these notifications commences on 1 December 2009 (N94325) and 2 December 2009 (N94327-8).

On the basis of the information that you have provided, it is not intended that further action be taken on these matters at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the immunity afforded by these notifications at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

This assessment has been made on the basis that MasterCard discloses all relevant terms and conditions to prospective customers.
