The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has received an application for re-authorisation (revocation and substitution) from the Board of Airline Representatives of Australia Inc (BARA). The ACCC invites you to comment on the application. Attached is a summary of the authorisation process including how to make a submission to the ACCC.

BARA and its members are seeking re-authorisation to negotiate and bargain collectively with airport operators and providers of other essential airport services at international airports, and agree on terms and conditions of acquisitions of such services, including prices, on an airport by airport basis.

The authorisation previously granted to these arrangements in July 2005 is due to expire on 29 July 2010.

## Request for submission

The ACCC invites you to make a submission on the likely public benefits and effect on competition, or any other public detriment, from the proposed arrangements.

If you intend to provide a submission in relation to BARA's application for re-authorisation, please do so by Friday 8 January 2010.

Alternatively, if you would like to provide comments orally, please contact Jessica Buik on 02 6243 4940 to organise a suitable time.

Submissions, including oral submissions, will be placed on the ACCC's public register subject to any request for exclusion (guidelines are attached).

## **Timetable**

The ACCC will progress its assessment of the application in a timely manner. An indicative timetable is set out below for your information.

11 December 2009	Public consultation process begins.
8 January 2010	Closing date for submissions from interested parties.
January 2010	Applicant responds to issues raised in the public consultation process.
March 2010	Draft determination.
March/April 2010	Public consultation on draft determination including any conference if called.
April/May 2010	Final determination.
