## Notification N94049 lodged by Ice Hockey Australia – notice

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC) has concluded its review of the exclusive dealing notification lodged by Ice Hockey Australia (IHA) on 27 July 2009.

The ACCC has issued a notice revoking the immunity provided by IHA's exclusive dealing notification. The reasons for the ACCC's decision are provided in the notice (a copy is attached). If no application for review of the notice is made to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal), the immunity afforded by the notification will cease to be in force on 2 April 2010.

## **Application for review**

Pursuant to section 101A of the Act, a person dissatisfied with the notice may apply to the Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of the notice; that is, on or before 23 March 2010.

An application for review of the notice should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
