As discussed yesterday afternoon, the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has received an application for revocation and substitution of an authorisation (re-authorisation) from the Board of Airline Representatives of Australia Inc (BARA). A draft determination was released by the ACCC on 24 March 2010.
