**Authorisations A91227 & A91228 lodged by Virgin Blue Airlines Pty Ltd and ors –  
request for material to be excluded from the public register**

I refer to the above applications for authorisation lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 6 May 2010.

I have considered your request that parts of the submission in support of the applications for authorisation be excluded from the ACCC's public register.

As you are aware, the ACCC is generally required under section 89 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974* (the Act) to place documents provided to it in relation to an application for authorisation on the ACCC's public register. The Act provides that a person submitting a document in relation to an authorisation application may request that the document or parts thereof be excluded from the public register by reason of the nature of certain information contained in the document.

As a person authorised to make a decision for and on behalf of the ACCC in relation to such a request, I advise that the relevant parts of the document will not be placed on the public register.
