## Board of Airline Representatives of Australia Inc (BARA) application for revocation and substitution of authorisation A91200 - final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for revocation and substitution of an authorisation (re-authorisation) lodged by the Board of Airline Representatives of Australia Inc (BARA) on 26 November 2009.

BARA sought re-authorisation to negotiate on behalf of its member international airlines from time to time with the operators of the major international airports and Gold Coast Airport, the Bureau of Meteorology, Airservices Australia and Unisys Australia Pty Limited.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached, including a summary of its reasons. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant conditional reauthorisation for five years. The ACCC's assessment is set out in Chapter 4 of its determination.

## **Application for review**

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 4 June 2010. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 5 June 2010.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
