**Casuarina All Sports Club Inc - Applications for authorisations A91201 & A91202 - final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the applications for authorisation lodged by the Casuarina All Sports Club Inc on behalf of the members of the Casuarina Business Precinct Stakeholders Committee (the Committee). Application A91201 was lodged on 30 November 2009. Application A91202 was lodged on 11 December 2009.

Casuarina All Sports Club Inc sought authorisation for authorisation of an agreement between businesses in the Casuarina Business Precinct in Darwin, know as the proposed Liquor Accord. Among other measures, the proposed Liquor Accord includes restrictions on the supply of certain types of alcohol products to consumers.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation until 3 June 2013.

**Application for review**

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before **2 June 2010**. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on **3 June 2010**.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
