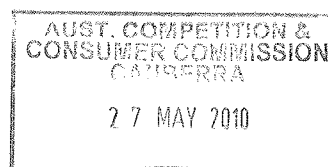

**Notifications N93304 – N93305 lodged in 2008 by Perth Motorplex and Avalon Raceway  
Request for Pre-decision Conference**

We act for the National Association of Speedway Racing (**NASR**).

We refer to your correspondence to NASR dated 13 May 2010. In particular, we refer to your previous communications with our client in respect of the Form G notifications of exclusive dealing (third line forcing) conduct filed by the operators of Perth Motorplex and Avalon Raceway in 2008 (the **Tracks**) (N93304 – N93305) (together, the **Notifications**) and to the Draft Notice issued by the ACCC on 13 May 2010, proposing to revoke the Notifications.

As you are aware, NASR has an interest in the Notifications as it is the governing body for the sport of Speedway racing in Australia. The notified conduct set out in the Notifications also directly relates to NASR, its licensing activities and the safety standards applicable for Speedway racing.
