# Premium Milk Ltd application for revocation and substitution A91236 - interested party consultation

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has received an application from Premium Milk Ltd (Premium) for the revocation of an existing authorisation and its substitution with a new one (application for re-authorisation). The ACCC invites you to comment on the application for re-authorisation. A summary of the authorisation process including how to make a submission to the ACCC is enclosed.

Premium currently has authorisation (A90972) to collectively negotiate farm-gate prices and milk standards on behalf of its members (milk producers located in southeast Queensland) with Parmalat Australia Ltd (Parmalat). This authorisation expires on 1 December 2010.

Premium is seeking to substitute this authorisation with a new authorisation (A91236) that would enable it to continue to collectively negotiate on behalf of its members with Parmalat for a further five years. Premium proposes to amend its Constitution so as to expressly allow it to represent milk producers operating in northern New South Wales as well as Queensland.

A copy of the application for re-authorisation is enclosed.

### Request for submissions

The ACCC invites you to make a submission on the likely public benefits and effect on competition, or any other public detriment, from the proposed arrangements.

If you intend to provide a submission in relation to Premium's application for reauthorisation, please do so by 22 July 2010.

Submissions, including oral submissions, will be placed on the ACCC's public register subject to any request for exclusion (guidelines are enclosed).

November 2010	Final determination.
