The ACCC spoke with NARA to clarify some aspects of the Australian Quality Training Framework, NARA's role and Agsafe's recent re-registration as a training provider.

In response to a series of questions, NARA provided the following information:

- NARA has responsibility for managing Agsafe's registration (and reregistration) as a training organisation under delegation from the ACT Accreditation and Recognition Council.
- Agsafe was re-registered for a 5 year period in August 2010. As part of this
 process, NARA confirmed that Agsafe is operating in compliance with the
 AQTF Essential Conditions and Standards for Continuing Registration which
 includes Condition of Registration 7 Recognition of Qualifications Issued by
 other RTO's. Condition 7 states that 'the RTO must recognise the AQF
 qualifications and Statements of Attainment issued by any other RTO'.
- NARA has no evidence that Agsafe is not complying with this condition.
- The AQTF does not require Agsafe to have all of its training programs accredited and NARA has no role with respect to the delivery of nonaccredited training by Agsafe.
