Outturning involves grain leaving CBH's custody, which means it must be weighed (among other functions). Trucks can use weighbridges at CBH sites but CBH has no infrastructure to weigh train carriages, so grain must be loaded into trucks, weighed, then unloaded again before re-loading onto trains. That is why outturning fees are higher for trains than for trucks. Note that for grain that is remaining in CBH's system, weighing on outloading is not required, so Grain Express outloading onto trains is substantially more efficient and less expensive than domestic outturns onto rail (or any rail outturn to a third party).

DOMESTIC & CONTAINER SITE TYPE GUIDELINES - 2007/08

Introduction

Co-operative Bulk Handling manages grain receival, storage and outturn services at almost 200 storage facilities spanning 28 designated areas in Western Australia. Each of these facilities has diverse levels of servicing capabilities. To assist customers in understanding these differences, CBH has formally classified each facility into site categories based on service capabilities as well as historical service usage requirements.

Classification

These site categories are numbered between one and four to allow customers to better identify the types of services generally available for each facility. As a general rule Site Types 1 and 2 facilities offer better receival and outturn services than Site Type 3 and grain stored at Site Type 4 facilities is only handled in a true bulk grain fashion.

Storage planning

It is intended that the Site Type classification method will assist Customers with the planning of receival, storage and outturn service requirements in partnership with CBH's ability to efficiently handle grain at different facilities. These guidelines identify storage facilities where servicing limitations exist, as well as facilities that offer increased access to grain.

Please note that each site consists of a number of different storage facilities. Each of these storage facilities has different outturning capabilities. For this reason, there can be occasions when grain can not be outturned according to the Site Type Guidelines. For example, site type 2's have no minimum outturn tonnages, however if a Site Type 2 has an open bulkhead, it is not practical to open this bulkhead to supply a customer with a small volume of grain.

Buyer beware

It is the responsibility of the Customer to ensure that grain acquisitions are made at suitably classified storage facilities that matches the intended use of that grain. This includes when:

- requesting grain receival services
- · purchasing grain from other grain buyers
- purchasing grain that has been warehoused by growers

Please also be aware, that regardless of Site Type, if the majority of a grain stack is outturned or moved such that the remaining tonnage is deemed by CBH to be insufficient to provide adequate storage management, CBH shall move this grain if it is unable to be outturned and Customers will be liable to pay the costs of moving the grain.

Transfers of Ownership

Ownership changes at all sites should occur as soon as possible, this will ensure freight costs are not incurred unnecessarily due to movements of grain.

Warehoused grain

Unless CBH has expressly agreed otherwise, CBH is not obliged to hold warehoused grain at the receival point of delivery. Prior to purchasing grain that has been warehoused by growers, it is recommended that Customers contact the CBH Logistics Department to check if the grain has moved to another Storage Facility.

Fumigation

Maintaining the quality of grain in storage is a key service priority and grain availability for Outturning is always subject to fumigation requirement protocols. Site Types 1 and 2 are less affected than Site Types 3 and 4 due to additional segregation availability but they may still suffer fumigation restrictions.

Flexibility

As always, CBH will endeavour to allow Customers flexibility due to seasonal conditions providing that Customers continue to work with CBH operationally to ensure cost efficiencies are maintained. Not withstanding this, nothing in these guidelines shall amend the terms of the Grain Services Agreement.

Site Type 1

Site Type 1 facilities are resourced throughout the year and grain can generally be Outturned when required. Domestic/Container Grain Outturning Services can be best undertaken from these facilities.

Receivals capabilities

- Major and minor grain segregation availability.
- Extended receival periods and hours.

Outturns capabilities

- No minimum daily tonnage rate.
- Grain easily accessed throughout the season.
- Grain Outturned to road or rail
- Grain available with 2 working days notice subject to stock availability.

Grain Movements

- CBH will endeavour to not move grain unless requested.
- Essential Harvest Movements apply across all site types due to harvest pressure.
- If CBH needs to move grain for operational reasons (other than Essential Harvest Movements), CBH will endeavour to advise Customers prior to any movement to allow the opportunity to outturn grain before it moves.

Site Type 2

Site Type 2 facilities are generally resourced throughout the year and grain can usually be Outturned as required. These facilities are suitable for Domestic/Container and Export Grain Outturning Services without minimum tonnage outturns.

Receivals capabilities

- Major and minor grain segregation availability. Extended receival periods and hours at some sites.

- Outturns capabilities

 No minimum daily tonnage rate.
- Grain accessed throughout the year.
- Grain Outturned to road or rail.
- Grain usually available within 5 working days of request subject to stock availability.

Grain Movements

- CBH will endeavour to not move grain unless requested.
- Essential Harvest Movements apply across all site types due to harvest pressure.
- If CBH needs to move grain for operational reasons (other than Essential Harvest Movements), CBH will endeavour to advise Customers prior to any movement to allow the opportunity to outturn grain before it moves.

Site Type 3

Site Type 3 facilities are generally only resourced during harvest receivals and when Outturning or transferring tonnages over minimum commitments. Outturning requirements dictate the allocation of staff and equipment resources across these facilities. These facilities are suitable for Export Grain Outturning Services and Domestic/Container Grain Outturning Services (where minimum tonnage outturns can be achieved and if planning with the CBH Logistics Department has occurred).

CBH will assist Customers by endeavouring to co-ordinate Outturning from these facilities to maximise the tonnage outturned over 400 tonnes and therefore gain efficiencies and minimise cost-recovery charges.

Receivals capabilities

- · Major and some minor grain segregations.
- · Some have extended receival periods and hours.

Outturns capabilities

- Minimum daily tonnage rate of 400 tonnes per day.
 (If Customers outturn requests contains tonnages less than the minimum 400 tonnes per day, CBH is entitled to reject the outturn request. If CBH agrees to the request, it is entitled to levy a surcharge for each tonne short of the daily outturn requirement see charge schedule attachment).
- Grain accessible intermittently throughout the season by arrangement.
- · Grain mostly Outturned to rail with some road capability.
- · Grain generally available within 10 days of request subject to stock availability

Grain Movements

- Essential Harvest Movements apply across all site types due to harvest pressure.
- If CBH needs to move grain for operational reasons (other than Essential Harvest Movements), if a Customer has more than 400 tonnes of a particular grade and season at the site, CBH will endeavour to advise Customers prior to any movement to allow the opportunity to outturn grain before it moves.
- If a Customer has less than 400 tonnes of a particular grade and season and has advised CBH in writing their intentions with the grain, CBH will also endeavour to comply with their intentions.

Comments:

The Outturning of grain in Site Type 3 facilities requires additional planning to either allow CBH to allocate suitable resources or to time Outturning with other Customer requirements. Cooperation between CBH, transporters and Customers will minimise charges and ensure efficiencies.

Options for Customers to maximise grain access (without minimum daily tonnage restrictions) and to prevent additional freight costs include:

- Stock swap grain to Site Type 1 or 2 facilities with other marketers (Transfer of Ownership);
- · Plan and discuss ahead with the CBH Logistics Department intentions of grain; or
- Physical consolidation of small tonnages to Site Type 1 or 2.

Site Type 4

Site Type 4 facilities are generally only resourced during harvest receivals and to transfer whole grain stacks to port facilities. Grain stacks within these Sites are only opened to outturn the whole stack or a large proportion of that stack. Grain stacks at these facilities are generally moved to export facilities prior to shipment. Site Type 4 facilities are not suitable for Domestic/Container/Bagging Outturning Services.

Receival capabilities

- Major grain segregations only.
- Minimum receival periods.

Outturn capabilities

- Minimum large tonnage Outturning rate (ie entire stacks, whole train consists).
- Grain generally only accessed once throughout the season.
- Grain generally only able to Outturn to rail.

Grain Movements

- Essential Harvest Movements apply across all site types due to harvest pressure.
- CBH reserves the right to move whole stacks to a transfer depot or Port facility when a majority owner requests grain located in the same Site/stack as the Customer's grain to be moved.

Comments:

Customers wishing to acquire grain at Site Type 4 facilities can:

- Stock swap grain to Site Type 1 or Site Type 2 facilities;
- Transfer ownership to a purchaser of export grain; or
- Negotiate resources to allow bulk grain movements or outturns.

Remuneration

All charges payable pursuant to this Agreement are to be paid in accordance with clause 20 of the Agreement. As set out in clause 21, CBH has the discretion not to Outturn Grain until all outstanding charges have been paid.

Grain Receival, Storage & Handling Charges 2008/09

The Charges Schedule outlines the CBH Board of Directors approved Storage and Handling Charges which will be altered only by the CBH Board.

The charges outlined apply from the 1st October 2008 to 30th September 2009. Any charges detailed after the 30th September 2009 are for illustration purposes only.

All prices are quoted in AUD and are exclusive of GST.

General Service Charges

1. Annual Registration Fee \$525.00 pa

This charge applies for the initial and on-going access to all services offered by CBH that forms part of the charges listed in this schedule and in the Grain Services Agreement.

The fee will apply upon signing and return of the Grain Services Agreement.

2. Code Translation Fee \$235.00 pa

Where customers have nominated to be set up for Client Access transmissions they are able to request a translation of the standard CBH codes. This will allow the information transmitted to be interpreted to match the customers own internal IT systems.

This charge is incurred where the customer requests CBH to transfer their entitlement (ownership) of grain from one owner to another through a Bulk Transfer of Ownership Form.

The charge is applied per tonne for the total request received dependant on the method in which it is submitted.

4. Overdue Payment Charges

Interest may be charged on overdue invoices, at the discretion of CBH Ltd.

The rate will be set annually at 31st October and amended more frequently where there is a significant increase in interest rates, at a rate of 5% above the current 90 day bank bill rate offered by the Commonwealth Bank of Australia or as specified in any other trading agreement signed by both the customer and CBH Ltd.

5. Grain Cleaning Service Charges

Grain cleaning services can be offered on-site at MGC and the ports. Charges will be advised on request.

Charge incurred on request of a site sample per commodity/grade which is representative of the stack of grain at the site.

Charges do not include freight or courier costs.

35. Pre-Shipment Container Sample Fee

Per sample ≤100kg

\$346.50

A sample of grain from Metro Grain Centre designated for a particular container loading contract which is collected before the containers commence loading.

Charges do not include freight or courier costs.

Container Loading & Bagging Service Charges

All container loading services are provided at the Metro Grain Centre (MGC) unless the customer is notified in writing by CBH of an alternative location.

The services provided include the transportation of containers to and from a nominated container depot, supply and fitting of standard bulka boards, sampling & AQIS inspections and the loading of grain stored within the MGC.

36. Container Loading Fee

\$27.50 p/t

Charge applies to 20 foot 8'6" Sea containers.

Farmer Dressed Bulk

For runs of six (6) or more containers loaded continuously during core hours

This charge is incurred when one or more containers are loaded to maximum capacity utilising standard CBH container loading equipment.

Where containers are of a different configuration this will be deemed as a Non-Standard Service and loading fees will be quoted upon request.

37. Small Contract Loading Fee

\$92. 40 per container

Where there is a loading run of less than 6 containers an additional charge per container shall apply on top of the Container Loading Fee.

Charge applies to 20 foot 8'6" Sea containers.

For runs of four (4) or more containers loaded continuously during core hours

This charge is incurred when one or more containers are loaded to maximum capacity utilising standard CBH container loading equipment.

Where containers are of a different configuration this will be deemed as a Non-Standard Service and loading fees will be quoted upon request.

39. Small Contract Loading Fee

\$179.00 per container

Where there is a loading run of less than 4 containers an additional charge per container shall apply on top of the Bagged Container Loading Fee.

40. Cancellation/Variation/Reschedule Fees

POA

For full details of the cancellation charges that will apply to all cancellations at different stages of the container contract are referred to in clause 8.9 & 8.10.

CBH requires information from the customer in 4 different stages and timelines, cancellation fees at different rates will apply at each stage.

41.	Blending fees	Blend onto Container	\$1.15 p/t

Blending fees are incurred where, at the request of the Customer, two ore more grain grades and/or seasons are blended on outloading into a container.

Where a customer has requested a pre-blend into cells, and this is then blended with other grain while outloading into a container the charge will be applied twice.

42. Non Standard Services

POA

For services provided that are outside of the normal operating practice of the Container Loading Services at MGC.

Services may include, but are not limited to:-

- Loading containers not of the standard configuration (eg. top loading)
- Loading containers from a point that is not one of the two main loading points
- Picking up containers from a non-standard location
- Dropping off containers at a non-standard location
- Transportation in a different method than the supply chain standard

Non-Standard services will be offered at CBH's discretion as the provision of same

may impede on the performance of the standard services.

43. Container Quality Inspection Fee

\$22 per container

Applied where customers appoint an independent representative to collect samples whilst containers are being loaded at the CBH Container Loading Facility at Metro Grain Centre.

44. Pre-Receival Advice Fee

\$52.75 per incident

Charge applied when customers request changes to PRA's or other documentation.

45. Contract Changes Administration Fee

\$75.00 per hour

Where customers request changes to contract details after loading due to the supply of incorrect information by the customer, a fee will be applied per hour to cover the administrative costs of cancelling and re-entering loads. Where an error is made by CBH no charges will apply.

Quotations of full costs can be supplied at the time of the request.

46. Transport Operator Performance

\$735 per hour

Where customer designate a non-CBH service provider for container transport, CBH standard operational benchmarks and cost recovery mechanisms apply as per below:-

Minimum Performance Target

The gross number of containers presented for loading under the conveyor must meet a minimum of four per hour.

Financial Penalty

A cost recovery will be charged at a rate of \$735 per hour for any shortfall in performance. Finanacial penalties that accrue under the above arrangements will be recovered from the customer to whom the operator is providing the services.

Please Note – this performance target applies to standard 20 foot containers. Targets and penalties for variations to this size are available by quotation.
