PaintRight Ltd considers that the markets affected by the proposed collective bargaining arrangement include paint re-sellers, paint suppliers, accessories suppliers and road transport services.

Paint resellers across Australia can be divided into paint specialists and hardware. Paint specialists can then be divided into groups or chains including 3D Inspirations, Bristol, Paint Place Group, Paint Spot, as well as manufacturer owned and controlled outlets and independents. Hardwares include Bunnings, Mitre 10, Home, as well as independents. Variety outlets such as Kmart and Big W also have paint offers.

The paint suppliers to PaintRight also sell to other paint resellers. PaintRight comprises about 2% of the paint reselling market in Australia.

When combined, Haymes, Wattyl, PPG and Dulux supply over 80% of the paint in Australia.

Suppliers of accessories to PaintRight also sell to other paint resellers. The combined accessories suppliers listed would supply over 95% of paint accessories in Australia.
