Third line forcing notification N96211 lodged by MasterCard Asia Pacific (Australia) Pty Ltd

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 18 October 2012. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

MasterCard Asia Pacific (Australia) Pty Ltd (MasterCard) proposes to offer products or services (in the form of a prize promotion involving flights, concert tickets, accommodation and spending money) to persons who have acquired a MasterCard credit card issued Westpac Banking Corporation (Westpac).

Legal immunity conferred by the notification commenced on 1 November 2012. On the basis of the information that you have provided, it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the immunity afforded by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

This assessment has been made on the basis that MasterCard and Westpac will disclose all relevant terms and conditions to prospective clients.
