# Transport Workers' Union Queensland Branch – application for authorisation A91331– Draft Determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) is proposing to grant authorisation in respect of the application lodged by The Transport Workers' Union of Australia Queensland Branch (the TWU) on 22 August 2012.

The TWU is seeking authorisation on behalf of existing and future owner-drivers to bargain collectively with Hanson Construction Materials Pty Ltd, for five years, over matters including:

- cartage rates (including the 'labour component')
- · a mechanism for those rates to increase from year to year
- penalties for carrying outside standard hours
- increased rates for specialist loads
- return on investment
- demurrage rates and
- equipment, including painting and badging of prime movers.

### **Draft determination**

A copy of the ACCC's draft determination and summary of its reasons is attached.

For the reasons set out in its draft determination, the ACCC proposes to grant authorisation for 5 years.

## **Next steps**

Once the ACCC issues a draft determination, the Applicant or any interested party may make a written submission and/or request that the ACCC convene a 'pre-decision conference'.

If you wish to make a submission in response to the ACCC's draft determination, please lodge your submission by **21 November 2012**.

A pre-decision conference provides the opportunity for interested parties to make oral submissions in relation to the draft determination. Conferences are conducted informally and while legal or professional advisers are able to attend they are not entitled to participate in the discussion.

If you wish the ACCC to hold a pre-decision conference in relation to the draft determination you must notify the ACCC in writing by **21 November 2012**.

The ACCC will consider any submissions it receives, including any oral submissions made should a pre-decision conference be called, and will then release a final determination in relation to these applications.

Submissions will be placed on the ACCC's public register subject to any request for exclusion. Please see the ACCC's publication <u>Guidelines for excluding information from the public register</u>.

## **Timetable**

The ACCC will continue to progress its assessment of the application in a timely manner. An updated indicative timetable is set out below for your information.
