**Canberra After-hours Locum Medical Service (CALMS Ltd) – Application for  
revocation of authorisation A91092 and substitution with A91276 – Final  
determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a final determination in respect of the application for revocation and substitution of authorisation lodged by Canberra After-hours Locum Medical Service (CALMS Ltd) on 23 September 2011.

For the reasons set out in its final determination, the ACCC revokes authorisation A91092 and grants authorisation A91276 in substitution, for CALMS Ltd to agree and set fee caps for the provision of after-hours primary medical care in the Australian Capital Territory. The ACCC grants authorisation for 10 years.

A copy of the ACCC's final determination is attached, including a summary of its reasons. The ACCC's assessment is set out in Chapter Four.

**Application for review**

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 19 March 2012. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 20 March 2012.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
