**South Australian Inghams Growers – Application for Authorisation A91294**

With reference to your letter dated 30 March 2012, and in clarification of the participants in the collective bargaining group, we advise as follows:

1. PJ and GE Samuel were in the group when preparation of the application for authorisation was commenced, but we understand that they have since transferred to Gourmet Poultry. It was an oversight that they were not deleted from the list.
2. KS and KL Braendler and MP and MA Braendler operate separate farms and as such are members of the collective group. With respect, we do not think it relevant that there is only one contract, relating to both farms. The application is made on behalf of the members from time to time of the South Australian Farmers Federation Inghams grower group. They are all members.
3. Dajmak Pty Ltd (as trustees for D & KA Tripodi Family Trust) should be included and was omitted in error.
4. Edge Ventures is not a member of the South Australian Farmers Federation Inghams grower group. Application is not made on behalf of Edge Ventures.
