I refer to your application for authorisation lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 29 May 2012.

## Request for exclusions from the ACCC's public register

I have considered the Australian Bankers' Association's (ABA's) request that Confidential Annexures A and E and references 13, 20 and 21 of the submission be excluded from the ACCC's public register.
