## Third line forcing notification N95743 - lodged by Rylely Pty Ltd trading as 3 Weeds Hotel

I refer to the above third line forcing notification relating to Rylely Pty Ltd's, trading as 3 Weeds Hotel, proposal to offer to give or give a discount in relation to the supply of goods and services on condition that the customer acquires the services of Doublestep Pty Ltd, trading as Topple. This notification was lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 6 March 2012.

By letter dated 29 November 2012, you advised that the proposed conduct is no longer proceeding and that Rylely Pty Ltd seeks to withdraw the notification. Section 93(7C) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* provides that the legal immunity conferred by the lodging of a third line forcing notification ceases to be in force when the notice is withdrawn.
