Dear Jamie,

We refer to your letter dated 19 December 2013 in respect to the draft determination for an authorisation lodged by the ATIC.

We wish to request a 'pre-decision conference' in response to the ACCC's draft determination.

Green Distillation Technology (GDT) is currently commercialising an innovative process to recover energy from end of life tyres (ELT). Oil, high grade carbon and scrap steel are produced from our environmentally sustainable process. Completion of the proof of concept was assisted with funding from the Federal Government via AusIndustry.

GDT submitted a response to the ATIC's draft guidelines as part of the public consultation process. While we retain some concern about the effectiveness of a voluntary model in a commercial environment encompassing a long supply chain and a diversity of interests, we support the need to overcome the environmental problems associated with ELTs. We are also determined that any economic benefit opportunities should remain in Australia.

We believe a conference is the most effective means to provide a response on such an important undertaking. Our items of interest include: (26) the proposed composition of the Board; (33) performance measures; (34 & 90) review process; (44) exporting of ELTs; (78) dealing with non-members; (87) reporting.

We look forward to the opportunity to meet with you.
