Re: Narta International Pty Ltd application for authorisation A91335
- PRE-DECISION CONFERENCE

Narta International Pty Ltd (Narta) has requested that the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) convene a conference in relation to the draft determination issued by the ACCC on 17 January 2013 proposing not to grant authorisation A91335.

The draft determination follows an application by Narta for authorisation in respect of a proposal to set a minimum advertising price on a range of consumer electrical goods. The ACCC concluded in its draft determination that overall it was not satisfied that the public benefit likely to flow from the proposed arrangements would outweigh the likely anti-competitive detriment and proposed to deny authorisation to the application. A copy of the application and draft determination can be found on the ACCC's website www.accc.gov.au/AuthorisationsRegister.

A pre-decision conference provides a valuable opportunity for applicants and interested parties to make oral submissions to the ACCC about its draft determination.

The ACCC will hold the conference on **15 February 2013**, at the ACCC's Sydney office at Level 20, 175 Pitt Street, Sydney. The conference will commence at 10:30am. ACCC Commissioner, Dr Jill Walker, will chair the conference.

Under the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the Act), the conference may be attended by the applicant and other interested parties. If you wish to attend, you must notify the ACCC of your intention by **close of business on 8 February 2013** and briefly indicate why you or your company or organisation has an interest in the matter. Notifications must be in writing and addressed to:

You should provide details of a contact name, telephone number, mailing address and, if possible, a facsimile number or e-mail address so that you can be notified of any late changes to conference arrangements.

If you represent a company or organisation you should also provide a list of attendees and their position titles, and indicate who will be the chief spokesperson.

I would also note that, while conference participants may bring outside legal or other professional advisers to assist them, the Act prohibits these advisers from participating in conference discussions.

Attached for your information are procedures usually followed at pre-decision conferences.

A copy of this letter has been placed on the ACCC's public register.
