Third line forcing notification N96951 lodged by Australian Karting Association Ltd

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 3 September 2013. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

The Australian Karting Association Ltd proposes to, from time to time, provide kart racers with the ability to participate in certain classes of competition on condition that the kart racer uses an engine that has been purchased from an approved supplier for that class of competition.

Legal protection conferred by the notification will commence on 17 September 2013.

On the basis of the information that you have provided it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the legal protection provided by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

This assessment has been made on the basis that the Australian Karting Association will disclose all relevant terms and conditions to prospective customers.
