Third line forcing notification N96995 lodged by Australian Health & Nutrition Association Limited t/a Sanitarium Health & Wellbeing Company

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 1 October 2013. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

The Australian Health & Nutrition Association Limited t/a Sanitarium Health & Wellbeing Company proposes to offer discounted entry fees to the Sanitarium Weet-Bix Kids Try-athlon series on condition the parent or guardian of the entrant is a member of a Bupa health fund or member of Triathlon Australia.

Legal protection conferred by the notification will commence on 15 October 2013.

On the basis of the information that you have provided it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the legal protection provided by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

This assessment has been made on the basis that the Sanitarium Health & Wellbeing Company will disclose all relevant terms and conditions to prospective customers.
