Existing Homeworkers Code of Practice

<u>Accreditation Documentation Requirements – as requested by ACCC</u>

Paperwork required from all accreditation applicant companies:

- Fees form
- Signed page 2 from the code (company details)
- Signed page 12 from the code (signatory page)

If the applicant company/contractor completes all manufacturing in-house – they must provide:

- Schedule 3A – Statutory declaration accepting terms of the code

If the applicant company gives work out to contractors – they must provide:

- Schedule 3 agreement between the applicant company and contractor
- Schedule 4 and attachment Statutory declaration accepting terms of the code (attachment lists contractors contact details)

If the applicant company gives work directly to outworkers – they must provide:

 Schedule 5 and attachment – Statutory declaration accepting terms of the code for an applicant company who gives work directly to outworkers (attachment lists outworkers contact details)

If a contractor receives work from a company/contractor and gives work to outworkers – they must provide:

- Schedule 6 and attachment – Statutory declaration accepting terms of the code (attachment lists outworkers contact details)

Documentation already required under current legislation:

- Registration with Fair Work Australia's Board of Reference (this includes providing a list of contractors to FWA and TCFUA)
- Work agreements with contractors and outworkers
- Wages records for employees and outworkers
- Superannuation payments evidence for employees and outworkers
- Work Cover evidence for employees and outworkers
- Work records (Garment Specification Sheet) given to contractors and outworkers
