Third line forcing notification N96744 lodged by Sandgroper Holdings Pty Ltd as Trustee for The Newman Electrical Unit Trust t/a Newman Retravision

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 20 May 2013. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

Sandgroper Holdings Pty Ltd as Trustee for The Newman Electrical Unit Trust trading as Newman Retravision (Newman Retravision) proposes to supply or offer to supply a range of telecommunications and related goods or services (including mobile phones, cordless phones, fax machines, phone cards, software, hand held computers, data products and internet starter packs) (TLS Products) and/or promotional goods or services (including vouchers, cinema tickets, electrical goods and accessories and food items) (Promotional Products) and proposes to give or allow a discount, allowance, rebate or credit in relation to these Products to customers, on condition that they acquire telecommunication services plans and/or related goods or services from Telstra.

Dealer Products include: mobile phones, cordless phones, fax machines, phone cards, software, handheld computers, data products and internet starter packs. Promotional Products include: vouchers, cinema tickets, electrical goods and accessories and food items.

Legal immunity conferred by the notification will commence on 3 June 2013.

On the basis of the information that you have provided, it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the immunity afforded by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

This assessment has been made on the basis that Newman Retravision will disclose all relevant terms and conditions to prospective customers.
