Hi Simon and Charles

An issue has arisen since the DCCC draft determination that we wanted to get your response to.

It's in relation to one of the eligibility criteria for producer members, set out at (d) of Schedule 3 to the Charter:

If the Producer Member is a haulage customer of a Rail Operator Member or Members, the Producer Member's Nominated Coal Throughput must include 100% of its contracted entitlements with that Rail Operator Member or Members.

Can you please explain the rationale for requiring 100% of a Producer Member's contracted entitlement with a Rail Operator Member to be included in the Nominated Coal Throughput, and why you have specified this rather than, for example, a requirement that all coal from a particular load point be included.
