Third line forcing notification N97230 lodged by Monkey Baa Theatre for Young People t/a Monkey Baa Theatre Company

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 6 February 2014. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

From 4 February 2014, Monkey Baa Theatre for Young People trading as **Monkey Baa Theatre Company** proposes to offer customers a free book and opportunity to meet the cast of Pete the Sheep on the condition that customers purchase tickets using a MasterCard.

Legal protection conferred by the notification will commence on 20 February 2014.

On the basis of the information that you have provided it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the legal protection provided by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

This assessment has been made on the basis that Monkey Bar Theatre Company and MasterCard will disclose all relevant terms and conditions to prospective customers.
