Australian National University and Ors – application for re-authorisation A91441-A91443 – final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by the Australian National University and nine other universities (the 'GAMSAT Consortium') on 27 June 2014.

As you may recall, the GAMSAT Consortium is seeking re-authorisation for the Interview Policy and Preference Policy governing the admission and interviewing of applicants to study medicine at their graduate-entry medical schools.

Determination

A copy of the ACCC's determination and summary of its reasons is attached.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation until 11 December 2024.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 10 December 2014. If no application for a review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 11 December 2014.

An application for a review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
