I protest the draft determination item 163, which indicates that there are other mechanisms for reporting commercial influence in research. Having raised again those matters submitted to Tess Macrae in July with both my institution's Ethics & Governance officer and the Director of the Centre for Ethics in Medicine to no avail, I sent my complaint to the co-founder of the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was concerned by inappropriate influence upon practitioners as has been raised by the RACGP, as well as by the inducement reporting framework proposal. Critical scrutiny from overseas can only harm any reputation for conduct of ethical research within Australia.
