**W.A.T.A.B Agents' Association Incorporated application for authorisation A91463 –
draft determination and interim authorisation**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a draft determination and has granted interim authorisation in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by W.A.T.A.B Agents' Association Incorporated (the Association) on 29 October 2014.

Draft determination

A copy of the ACCC's draft determination and summary of its reasons is attached.

For the reasons set out in its draft determination, the ACCC proposes to grant authorisation for ten years.

Interim authorisation

The ACCC has also granted interim authorisation to allow the Association to commence negotiations with RWWA. The interim authorisation will remain in place until the date the ACCC's final determination comes into effect, or until the ACCC decides to revoke interim authorisation.

This interim authorisation does not extend to the Association's members collectively entering into any contracts with RWWA.

Next steps

Once the ACCC issues a draft determination, the Applicants or any interested party may make a written submission and/or request that the ACCC convene a 'pre-decision conference'.

If you wish to make a submission in response to the ACCC's draft determination, please lodge your submission by **10 December 2014**. Submissions should be emailed to

adjudication@acc.gov.au with the subject "A91463 – from W.A.T.A.B Agents' Association Incorporated – submission".

A pre-decision conference provides the opportunity for interested parties to make oral submissions in relation to the draft determination. Conferences are conducted informally and while legal or professional advisers are able to attend they are not entitled to participate in the discussion. If you wish the ACCC to hold a pre-decision conference in relation to the draft determination you must notify the ACCC in writing by **10 December 2014**.

The ACCC will consider any submissions it receives, including any oral submissions made should a pre-decision conference be called, and will then release a final determination in relation to the application.

Submissions will be placed on the ACCC's public register subject to any request for exclusion. Please see the ACCC's publication [Guidelines for excluding information from the public register](#).

Timetable

You have sought consideration of the collective bargaining application under the ACCC's streamlined process for small business collective bargaining arrangements. An indicative timetable is set out below for your information.
