Queensland Office of Liquor and Gaming Regulation application for revocation of authorisations A91224 & A91225 and substitution of new authorisations A91385 & A91386 – final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for re-authorisation (application for revocation and substitution) received from the Queensland Office of Liquor and Gaming Regulation (OLGR) on 17 September 2013.

The OLGR sought re-authorisation for the responsible service of alcohol provisions of its pro-forma liquor accord arrangement.

A copy of the ACCC's determination and summary of its reasons is attached.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant conditional re-authorisation until 9 January 2020.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 8 January 2015. If no application for a review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 9 January 2015.

An application for a review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
