## Third line forcing notification N98055 lodged by Hyundai Motor Company Australia

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 19 December 2014. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

Hyundai proposes to offer extended warranties on motor vehicles on condition that the customer has the vehicle serviced by, and any repairs undertaken under the warranty performed by, an authorised Hyundai dealer.

Legal protection conferred by the notification will commence on 2 January 2015.

On the basis of the information that you have provided it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the legal protection provided by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

This assessment has been made on the basis that Hyundai will disclose all relevant terms and conditions to prospective customers.
