Third line forcing notification N97360 lodged by P & J Crossroads Pty Ltd

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 9 April 2014. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

P & J Crossroads Pty Ltd t/a Aubergine Sydney (Aubergine) proposes to offer an upgrade from one to two lamb shanks, on condition customers pay with a Mastercard.

Legal protection conferred by the notification will commence on 23 April 2014.

On the basis of the information that you have provided it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the legal protection provided by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

This assessment has been made on the basis that Aubergine and Mastercard will disclose all relevant terms and conditions to prospective customers.
