NBN Co application for re-authorisation (A91479-A91481) of revised arrangements concerning Optus' HFC network – Draft Determination

We refer to your letter dated 23 July 2015 which attached a copy of the Commission's Draft Determination. The Commission proposes to grant authorisation for the proposed arrangements between Optus and NBN Co.

The Draft Determination identifies public benefits, particularly arising from the avoidance of duplication of assets (by means of NBN Co's long term access to fibre components of the Optus HFC Network) and also from access to spectrum on the Optus HFC Network through the migration period (facilitating less disruptive migration for customers). Optus supports the Commission's identification of those public benefits from the revised arrangements, and agrees that those benefits are significant.

Optus agrees that the revised arrangements will produce additional public benefits and no additional detriments as compared to the existing authorised arrangements going forward. As a result, Optus fully endorses the Commission's proposed grant of authorisation for the revised arrangements for 35 years. Optus does not consider that a 'pre-decision conference' is necessary.

In the event that a pre-decision conference is called or submissions from third parties raise further issues, Optus would wish for an opportunity to make further comments.
