I agree with what is proposed (below):

“Based on the information before it, the ACCC proposes to amend the individual reporting requirement to ensure all relevant transfers of value are reported. The ACCC also proposes to impose conditions to require a common reporting format that is accessible, to require Medicines Australia to use reasonable endeavours to implement a centralised reporting system and to report regularly on progress, and to require publication and retention of reports for three years instead of two. The ACCC is also proposing a procedural condition in respect of future non-material amendments to the conditions.”

“The ACCC is not proposing to impose conditions in relation to ongoing food and beverage reporting or drug name reporting at this time”.

A suitable compromise!
