Parliamentary Inquiry into breastfeeding and Knowles report state voluntary Code not strong enough and does not apply to chemists or big supermarket chains.

97% of women start breastfeeding. Without family and community support it is difficult. Some women need artificial baby milk due to ill health, hemorrhage or adoption however WHO recommend a human mother provide her own milk or donor human milk be used before cow or soy protein. Dr. Jenny James has called for prescriptions to be used before the use of artificial milk, I see new mothers daily and would recommend expert help before commencing artificial milk. Prof. Paula Meier a neonatologist stated any milk other than human milk can set up an inflammatory response in an infants gut.
