The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) is currently consulting on an application for revocation and substitution of a new authorisation received from the Clean Energy Council Limited (CEC).

The purpose of this letter is to invite you, as a potentially interested party, to comment on that application.

Application

The CEC administers a voluntary code of conduct for solar photovoltaic (PV) retail businesses (the Code). The CEC seeks to have the current authorisation revoked and substituted by a revised version of the Code. The revised Code contains new provisions regarding consumer finance, grid connection procedure and privacy. It also contains an amended fee structure.

The ACCC invites you to make a submission on the likely public benefits and effect on competition, or any other public detriment, from the proposed arrangements.

The ACCC would also welcome your views on the public benefits and detriments you consider have actually resulted from the arrangements during the previous authorisation period.

If you intend to provide a submission in relation to the CEC's application, please do so by 26 May 2015. Submissions should be emailed to adjudication@accc.gov.au with the subject "A91495 & A91496 - CEC - submission."

Alternatively, if you would like to provide comments orally, please contact Zoe Kent on 03 9290 1948 to organise a suitable time.

Submissions, including oral submissions, will be placed on the ACCC's public register subject to any request for exclusion. Please see the ACCC's publication Guidelines for excluding information from the public register.

Please advise if you do not wish to make a submission at this time, but would like to be informed of the progress of the applications at the draft and final determination stages. If you are able to, please provide a nominated contact email address for future correspondence.

You can also forward this letter to any other party who may wish to make a submission to the ACCC regarding the application.
