Application for re-authorisation A91479-A91481 from NBN Co Limited – request for material to be excluded from the public register

I refer to Optus' written response and internal documents provided to the ACCC on 29 May 2015.

I have considered your request that parts of Optus' written response and the four internal documents be excluded from the ACCC's public register.

As you are aware, the ACCC is generally required under section 89 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the Act) to place documents provided to it in relation to an application for authorisation on the ACCC's public register. The Act provides that a person submitting a document in relation to an authorisation application may request that the document or parts thereof be excluded from the public register by reason of the nature of certain information contained in the document.

As a person authorised to make a decision for and on behalf of the ACCC in relation to such a request, I advise that the relevant parts of Optus' written response and attached internal documents will not be placed on the public register.

I note that you also provided a public version of Optus' written response. This version will be placed on the public register in the form it was provided to the ACCC.
