Association of Magazine Publishers of Australia Inc application for authorisation A91472 - determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by the Association of Magazine Publishers of Australia Inc (MPA) on 27 November 2015.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation until 17 July 2016.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 16 July 2015. If no application for a review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 17 July 2015.

An application for a review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
