Application for Minor Variation to Authorisations A91205 to A91207 Rio Tinto Aluminium and others (Gladstone Power Station) — determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination varying authorisations A91205 to A91207 granted to Rio Tinto Aluminium Ltd and others (the Applicants) on 2 June 2010.

The minor variation enables the Applicants to give effect to amendments to the Operation and Maintenance Agreement for the Gladstone Power Station.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before **4 March 2016**. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on **5 March 2016**.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
