Thank you for your letter of 5 February 2016 inviting comment on a further submission to the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC) seeking authorisation of the ihail Pty Ltd application (A91501).

I refer to the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) previous correspondence to the ACCC dated 2 December 2015. In that correspondence, TMR raised concerns about the priority dispatch/tipping function which, if enabled, may result in the fare exceeding the maximum fare that can be charged for taxi services in Queensland, and as a result, a breach of passenger transport laws.

TMR's position has not changed. However, TMR notes that in its further submission, ihail is no longer seeking authorisation from ACCC for the priority dispatch/tipping function and that it will act in accordance with the laws and regulations of each jurisdiction regarding the applications use.
